

## INTERIM REPORT for I-III 2018 Group Medika



### Management interim report

### Comment on the business results for the first quarter of 2018

Medika Group ("the Group") has realised total revenue in the first three months of 2018 in amount of HRK 762.3 million which is by 9.67% higher comparing to the same period of previous year.

Sales revenues which amount to HRK 748.8 million for the first three months of 2018 are by 10.17% higher comparing to the same period of previous year.

Share of sales revenues in the total revenue is 98.23% while in the same period of previous year it was 97.79%.

Other operating revenues which amount to HRK 4.0 million are lower by HRK 2.5 million comparing to the same period of previous year. Share of other operating revenues in total revenue was only 0.93 % in the first three months of 2017, and in the first three months of 2018 is 0.52%.

Out of the total sales revenues, 99.98% revenues are generated on domestic market, while 0.02% is generated on the foreign market. This structure in the first three months of 2018 has not changed comparing to the same period of previous year.

Material expenses amount to HRK 693.5 million and are 10.11% higher comparing to the same period of previous year, which is in accordance with the growth of sales revenue. Since the operating expenses are growing in lower percentage, share of material expenses in the operating expenses is higher by 0.79% comparing to the same period of previous year and amounts to 94.29%.

Employee expenses are lower by 2.50% comparing to the same period of previous year. Their share in the total expenses amounts to 3.38% while in the same period of previous year it amounted to 3.78%. Decrease in employee expenses is influenced by lower average number of employees in the first quarter of 2018 compared to the same period of the previous year.

Impairment of current assets amounts to HRK 4.3 million and is lower compared to the same period of previous year. Impairment of accounts receivables is lower compared to the same period of the previous year because at the end of the 2017 there was debt repair for the hospitals. Also, in the first quarter of 2017 impairment of the interest receivables from Agrokor was recorded in the amount of HRK 1.1 million.

Finance income has increased compared to the same period of the previous year for HRK 599 thousand, that is 6.70%. In the structure of the financial positive foreign exchange differences are lower compared to the same period of the previous year for HRK 1.5 million, while interest income is higher for HRK 2.1 million. In the interest income structure, interest income on given loans is lower, because in the first quarter of 2017 the interest income on the loan on the loan given to Agrokor d.d. was recorded, while in the first quarter of 2018 interest was not charged according to the Act on the procedure of Extraordinary Administration in Commercial Companies with Systemic Importance for the Republic of Croatia. At the same time, based on the court settlement, default interest income was recorded in the amount of HRK 3.8 million.



Finance expenses have decreased compared to the same period of previous year by HRK 874 thousand, which is 23.35%. Their share in the total expenses is by 0.16% lower compared to the same period of previous year and amounts to 0.39%. In the structure of financial income foreign exchange expenses are higher by HRK 215 thousand, while interest expenses are lower by HRK 1.0 million as a result of lower interest rates and lower indebtedness comparing to the same period of previous year.

Gross margin in the first three months of 2017 amounted to 9.03%, while in the first three months of 2018 amounts to 9.15%, which is increase by 0.12%. Increase is a result of larger increase in net sales revenue comparing to the increase in net cost of goods sold.

Gross profit (profit before taxation) amounts to HRK 23.9 million, while in the same period of previous year amounted to HRK 17.7 million, which is increase of HRK 6.2 million, or 35.14%. Higher gross profit is result of greater increase of total revenue (increase of 9.67% comparing to the same period of previous year mostly due to the increase in sales revenue) in relation to the increase of total expenses (increase of 9.01% comparing to the same period of previous year)

Operative earnings amount to HRK 17.2 million and are by HRK 4.7 million, which is 37.95% higher comparing to the same period of previous year.

Realised net profit amounts to HRK 19.0 million.

Transactions with the related parties in the first three months of 2018 generated total net revenues in amount of HRK 9.6 million, which is by 10.12% higher of generated revenue in the same period of previous year when it amounted to HRK 8.7 million.

Trade goods purchased from the related parties amount to HRK 48.6 million, while in the same period of the previous year amounted to HRK 56.4 million, which is decrease of HRK 7.7 million, that is 13.73%.

Total assets amount to HRK 2 billion 55.5 million and have not significantly changed compared to the beginning of the year.

Long term assets have increased by HRK 6.2 million, that is 1.44%, compared to the beginning of the year. Long term intangible assets have increased by HRK 2.3 million compared to the beginning of the year mostly as a result of acquisition of pharmacy in Bibinje. Tangible assets have decreased by HRK 2.2 million compared to the beginning of the year.

Long term financial assets mostly relate to the investment in related parties and in smaller part to the given loans. Long term financial assets amount to HRK 37.6 million and are by HRK 6.0 million higher compared to the beginning of the year mostly due to the increase in given loans to business partners.

Deferred tax assets have not significantly changed comparing to the beginning of the year.

Short term assets amount to HRK 1 billion 618.1 million and are almost at the same level compared to the beginning of the year. In the structure of short term assets financial assets, receivables and inventory have increased, while cash in bank and on hand have decreased compared to the beginning of the year.

Inventory amounts to HRK 317.9 million and has increased by HRK 10.7 million comparing to the beginning of the year, which is 3.47%.



Total short term receivables amount to HRK 1 billion 138.0 million and are higher for HRK 27.4 million, which is 2.47%, comparing to the beginning of the year. Trade receivables, receivables from related parties and receivables from participating parties amount to HRK 1 billion 127.0 million and have increased by 3.16% comparing to the beginning of the year.

Amount of HRK 35.4 million of receivables from customers from Agrokor Group was converted into incremental loan (roll-up loan) by which receivables in the same amount were closed and the receivables for incremental loan were recorded in the amount of HRK 35.4million within short term financial assets.

Short term financial assets amount to HRK 87.9 million and relate to short term given loans. Comparing to the beginning of the year they have increased for HRK 35.1 million. This increase is result of recording incremental loan (roll-up loan) from Agrokor.

Cash in bank and on hand amounts to HRK 74.3 million and is lower by HRK 70.5 million compared to the beginning of the year. At the end of 2017 part of the funds from the debt repair of hospitals was received which increased this balance sheet item. Received funds were used for decreasing indebtedness in 2018.

In equity, there was no change compared to the beginning of the year.

Long term liabilities amount to HRK 21.6 million, out of which HRK 5.7 million relate to finance lease liabilities and HRK 15.9 million to deferred tax liabilities.

Short term liabilities amount to HRK 1 billion 572.8 million out of which the biggest part in amount of HRK 1 billion 211.8 million relates to trade payables and liabilities to related parties and HRK 328.6 million to indebtedness (HRK 326.3 million to short term loans and HRK 2.3 million to finance lease).

Trade payables and liabilities to related parties are higher for HRK 41.3 million comparing to the beginning of the year, which is 3.53%.

Total loans liabilities of Medika Group amounts to HRK 326.3 million which is decrease of HRK 40.0 million comparing to the beginning of the year. All loans are short term loans and denominated in HRK so there is no exposure to foreign exchange risk at this balance sheet items.

### Key events

Total pharmaceutical market in the first three months of 2018 has increased comparing to the same period of previous year. At the same time, sales of Medika have increased slightly slower comparing to the market increase, which has not significantly influenced market share.

Amount of HRK 35.4 million of receivables from customers from Agrokor Group was converted into incremental loan (roll-up loan) by which receivables in the same amount were closed and the receivables for incremental loan were recorded in the amount of HRK 35.4 million within short term financial assets.

Total indebtedness has decreased for HRK 40.0 million compared to the beginning of the year.

ZU Ljekarne Prima Pharme acquired pharmacy in Bibinje.



### Expected future development of the Group

The Company will continue with its core business: distribution of medicinal products and medical devices will strongly develop operations with products that make the core business of the firm.

Development strategy of Prima Pharme is to expand network of pharmacies on whole territory of Croatia.

### Treasury shares

As at 31.03.2018, the Company holds 1,440 treasury shares.

### Subsidiaries and associates

The Company has subsidiaries Zdravstvena ustanova Ljekarne Prima Pharme and Primus nekretnine d.o.o. Both subsidiaries are fully owned by the Company.

ZU Ljekarne Prima Pharme has 100% of ownership in subsidiaries ZU Ljekarne Delonga, ZU Ljekarne Ines Škoko and associate ZU Ljekarne Jagatić in which it holds 49% of ownership.

### Related parties

The company with major voting rights, Auctor d.o.o. owns 47.38% of the Company and has 49.75% of shares with voting rights.

Pliva Hrvatska d.o.o., Zagreb owns 25.32% of the Company and has 26.59% of the voting rights. Given the share in the ownership and business transactions with the Company, Pliva Hrvatska d.o.o. has significant influence on the current operations of the Company.

### Financial risks and exposure to price risk, credit risk, liquidity and cash flow risk

Within financial risks, foreign exchange risk is significant. The Group's purchase of goods is partly realised on the foreign market. The Group is therefore exposed to foreign exchange risk arising from various changes in foreign exchange rates mainly linked to the EUR. All loans are kuna-denominated; hence, there is no exposure to foreign exchange risk. With part of the foreign suppliers the payment currency is agreed in Croatian kuna. It is the tendency in the future to agree payments in Croatian kuna with as many existing foreign suppliers as possible so as to minimise the risk arising from transactions with foreign suppliers.

The Group has part of assets which are interest-bearing so the Group's income and operating cash flows are dependent of changes in market interest rates.

The Group's interest rate risk arises from short term and long term given loans and borrowings with variable interest rates. Borrowings with fixed interest rates expose the Group to the fair value interest rate risk exposure.

The Group does not use derivative instruments to actively hedge cash flow and fair value interest rate risk exposure. However, the Group continuously monitors changes in interest rates. Various scenarios are simulated taking into account refinancing, renewal of existing positions and alternative financing.



Price risk arises from a continuous decrease in the price of HZZO's List of medicinal products and administrative approach in determining prices and margins of medicinal products. To lower this risk, the Group focused on increase of variety of products which are not limited by law in respect of the price of the product.

Majority of the credit risk relates to trade receivables and receivables for given loans. Credit risk is higher when dealing with pharmacies, which have potential going concern issue. However, hospitals which have longer collection period do not have a going concern issue and collection issue.

Out of the total amount of short term receivables, HRK 94.7 million relates to the receivables from companies within Agrokor Group which has undergone in liquidity problems. Out of the total amount, HRK 50.0 million relates to the given loan that is secured by pledge on the shares (gross amount of the loan amounts to HRK 100.0 million and the impairment HRK 50.0 million), HRK 35.4 million to receivables for incremental loan and the remaining on the receivables for the sold goods to the veterinary customers within Agrokor Group.

The most significant risk within market risks is a long collection period of receivables, especially HZZO and HZZO related receivables. Therefore, a significant amount of working capital is not available what has an influence on cash flows and timely settlement of Medika liabilities.

As these receivables are directly or indirectly related to the receivables from the State institutions, the collection of these receivables should not be classified as a risk. This increases the need for additional financing, which increases finance expenses.
