INTERIM MANAGEMENT REPORT

for the time period from January 1 to June 30, 2011

Most significant events that took place in the reporting period and the effects thereof on the abridged set of financial statement

In the first six months of 2011, Varteks d.d. marked HRK 9.4 million higher sales revenues in relation to the same time period last year.

On the foreign market, exports worth HRK 65.1 million were realized, which constitutes an increase of 10.3 percent in relation to the same time period last year. The majority of exports continue to be realized in the European Union, and the export activity results show a slight recovery in the negative trends in Europe's economy.

Total revenues amounted to HRK 144.5 million and are 7.4 percent lower in relation to the revenues realized in the same time period last year. The difference is evident in the item "other business revenues" and is not related to the Company's regular business activities, it largely emerged from revenues from real estate sales, which amounted to HRK 15 million in the same time period last year.

Total expenditures in the first six months of 2011 amounted to HRK 176 million, which is 1 percent more than the total expenditures realized in the same time period in 2010.

In the first six months of this year, the Company operated with a loss of HRK 31.2 million, while a loss of HRK 17.9 million had been realized in the same time period last year. The negative difference in relation to the same time period last year derived from the effects of aforementioned real estate sales realized last year. Excluding the effects of revenues from real estate sales, business operations for the time period from Jan.-Dec. 2011 exhibit a HRK 1.7 million better total result in relation to the same time period in 2010.

It is important to point out that as of May 2011, the Company's manufacturing part was detached through business reorganization into three separate limited liability companies in line with the elements of the Integral Business and Financial Restructuring Plan. In order to properly compare the total effects from business operations in relation to last year's operations (operations prior to aforementioned reorganization), the business results for the first six months of 2011 must be viewed jointly with the results of the newly founded limited liability companies, which results in a loss of HRK 28 million, while the total loss is HRK 3.2 million lower than the loss of Varteks d.d., i.e. excluding the effects from real estate sales, results from regular business activities were HRK 4.9 million higher in relation to the same time period last year.

In relation to the implementation of the Integral Plan and the reorganization and in connection to revenue realization it is also important to point out that the B2B segment

(sales aspect in relation to corporate clothing and the manufacturing of special-purpose clothing) was detached to an affiliated company owned by Varteks d.d. after the first quarter of 2011 in line with the restructuring and reorganization plan. If we compare the total revenues from this sales aspect for the time period Jan.-Dec. 2011, they amounted to HRK 23.1 million more in relation to the same time period last year, i.e. total sales revenues were 18 percent higher.

Također vezano uz provedbu Integralnog plana i reorganizaciju, te uz realizaciju prihoda, važno je napomenuti da je sukladno planu restrukturiranja i reorganizacije, kroz tvrtku kćer u vlasništvu Varteksa d.d., nakon prvog kvartala 2010. godine izdvojen segment B2B poslova (vid prodaje vezan uz područje korporativnog odijevanja i izradu odjeće za specijalne namjene).

Although business results exhibit positive characteristics when looking at regular business activities, the total business result continues to be negative. A significant negative influence emerges from the drop in personal spending and general insolvency on the market, which is particularly evident in operations in relation to the domestic market.

The negative trend on the real estate market has caused further difficulties in the implementation of activities in relation to stabilizing the company's liquidity, which directly resulted in the impossibility to procure raw materials and production materials on time, to procure and deliver products and merchandise to the retail network in a timely manner and which significantly affected the business result of Varteks d.d.

Most significant risks and developments for the remainder of the business year

Due to the economic problems and the continuous effects from the crisis, certain risks appear on the basis of a potential further increase in insolvency, which could additionally impede the timely procurement of goods and the financing of business activities. There is also the risk of a further reduction in personal spending, which directly affects revenues, and the risk of cost increases on the basis of further energy price increases.

In accordance with current market conditions, Varteks continues to actively focus on targeted development and increasing sales in certain sales aspects. The business segment pertaining to the manufacturing and sale of special-purpose clothing and corporate clothing continuously exhibits significant growth in business revenues and results, while growth is also continuously present in revenues realized through exports.

In line with the Integral Business and Financial Restructuring Plan, cost cutting measures are carried out through the closure of unprofitable parts of the system and through further cuts in administration costs, as well as through measures directed towards the financial consolidation of the Company through the utilization of its own assets as an additional financing source and activities aimed towards the use of Government measures for economic recovery and development.

The Company's stabilization and the development of its business operations is primarily based on the financial consolidation of business operations and liquidity stabilization as key prerequisites for the implementation of all activities in relation to the restructuring, the further reorganization of the system and the strengthening of strategic sales aspects.
