



**Zagreb, 4 August 2011** - Atlantic Grupa d.d. received on 15 July 2011 the decree of the Croatian Financial Services Supervisory Agency, whereby the procedure for the approval of the bid for takeover of the company KALNIČKE VODE BIO NATURA d.d. is suspended, as the legal requirements for its conduct are no longer applicable.

On the same day Atlantic Grupa d.d. received a further decree of the Croatian Financial Services Supervisory Agency, whereby it is obliged to pay an additional amount of HRK 89.32 per registered share to all persons who on 23 December 2010 had registered on their securities account with the Central Depository & Clearing Company Inc. the shares of KALNIČKE VODE BIO NATURA d.d., Križevci, Bjelovarska 4, within 90 days as of receipt of the decree.

With regard to said decisions of the Financial Services Supervisory Agency, the Board of Atlantic Grupa d.d. shall use the statutory afforded legal instruments, i.e. the right of law suit before the Administrative Court, as well as the request for postponement of the enforcement until the final decision of the Administrative Court. The enforcement of decree of the Croatian Financial Services Supervisory Agency would mean that Atlantic Grupa d.d. has to pay an additional amount of HRK 7.6 million to the minority shareholders of KALNIČKE VODE BIO NATURA d.d.
