Pursuant to Article 48, Paragraph 3, of the Financial Operations and Pre-Bankruptcy Settlement Act (Official Gazette Nos 108/12, 144/12, hereinafter referred to as the Act), and following the proposal made by the debtor INSTITUT IGH, joint stock company for research and development in civil engineering, OIB 79766124714, Janka Rakuše 1, Zagreb 10000, the Settlement Council ZG07 composed of Anka Vukadin, Council President, and Martina Čeović and Ana Fabris, as Council members, reached the following

DECISION

on Temporary Measure

- The Financial Agency is herewith ordered to stop the distraint and claim security procedures instituted in relation to the debtor INSTITUT IGH, joint stock company for research and development in civil engineering, OIB 79766124714.
- II. The temporary measure from Section I of the operative part of this Decision shall come into force on the day it is proclaimed.
- III. The temporary measure from Section I of the operative part of this Decision shall remain in force until 3 June 2013.
- IV. This temporary measure shall be delivered to the Financial Agency to enable suspension of the distraint and claim security procedures.
- V. Ms. Davorka Huljev from Zagreb, Miramarska 13d, OIB 34743014377 has been appointed as the Pre-bankruptcy Settlement Trustee.

Exposition

The debtor INSTITUT IGH, joint stock company for research and development in civil engineering, OIB 79766124714, submitted on 17 May 2013 its Proposal for the Institution of the Pre-Bankruptcy Settlement Procedure, and submitted on the same day its Proposal for Temporary Measure.

In its Temporary Measure Proposal the debtor specified that it employs more than 700 persons, and that it is one of the biggest design, consulting and research companies in the field of research and development in civil engineering. Considering the debtor's economic significance and its role on Croatian market, difficult consequences would occur in case of continued blockage of the debtors account, with repercussions on many economic entities in the Republic of Croatia, and also on the debtor's employees and their dependents.

In order to prevent difficult and irreparable effects on the continued conduct of the debtor's business, and to permit payment of salaries to its employees, the Council has made its decision in application of Article 48, Paragraph 3, of the Act, as stated in the operative part of the Decision.

Legal remedy: A complaint may be lodged against this decision. The deadline for submittal of complaints is eight days after delivery of the Decision. The complaint must be submitted to the Financial Agency. The complaint shall be decided upon by the Ministry of Finance, Independent Sector for the Second Instance Administrative Procedures. According to Article 30, Paragraph 7, of the Act, any complaint lodged against the decision shall not delay the enforcement of the decision.
