**Subject: The Port of Rijeka was awarded almost 34 million Euros of non-refundable funds for reconstruction and upgrading of the port infrastructure in Rijeka and in Bakar**

According to the news from the European Commission and the Ministry of Sea, Transport and Infrastructure received on Friday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017, Luka Rijeka d.d. was granted the co-financing of two projects from the Connecting Europe Facility – Transport (CEF).

Luka Rijeka d.d. and the Port of Rijeka Authority jointly successfully submitted applications to the European Commission for two projects of reconstruction and upgrading of the infrastructure in the port basins of Rijeka and Bakar for co-financing from the Connecting Europe Facility – Transport (CEF). The value of both projects is estimated at 39.93 million Euros. The estimated value of the project “Reconstruction and upgrading of the Rijeka port infrastructure – Rijeka basin (POR2CORE-Rijeka Basin)” amounts to 33.84 million Euros and the value of the project “Reconstruction and upgrading of the Rijeka port infrastructure – Bakar Basin)” amounts to 6.09 million Euros. The reconstruction and upgrading in both projects include demounting and removal of the existing infrastructure, construction of new roads, port crane tracks, industrial tracks, electric installations, and water supply and drainage systems. Both projects have a significant component related to environment protection.

The project applications were submitted at the beginning of February 2017 following the third call of the European Commission for co-financing key transport projects via CEF funds. Luka Rijeka d.d. was granted the maximum financing amount of 85% or almost 34 million Euros of non-refundable funds.
